## SPECIAL NOTES REFERRING ONLY TO THIS SHEET

- 1 The charges shown are intended to be a simple guide and not a comprehensive list.
- 2 Exchange line charges are not included. These are given in leaflet General Information 1.
- 3 PABXs 1 and 2 are supplied by the Post Office on rental terms. Both systems are available in four sizes and the charges quoted for each size include the cost of providing and maintaining the whole installation.
- 4 PABXs 3 and 4 are not supplied by the Post Office and any customer requiring one of these systems must buy the equipment from an approved contractor who will also be responsible for installing it. The Post Office provides the extension wiring and telephones and maintains the whole installation for the charges shown. A list of approved contractors will be provided on request.
- 5 The connexion and rental charges shown for extensions are for those in the same building as the PABX. For each extension in another

building there is normally a connexion charge of £5 and an additional rental based on distance.

- 6 The connexion charges shown for switchboards, switching equipment and wiring are fixed. The connexion charges shown for extensions are maxima; when extensions are ordered at the same time as the PABX to which they are to be connected, or subsequently when more than one extension is ordered at the same time, or when an extension is ordered at the same time as another major item, these charges are reduced.
- 7 When a new PABX is installed modern telephones are provided on all extensions and a single charge of £1 is made for each telephone.
- 8 Connexion charges and rentals for interswitchboard (inter-PBX) lines are not given, as provision depends upon the intercommunication facilities required and the distances between the PBXs concerned.
