

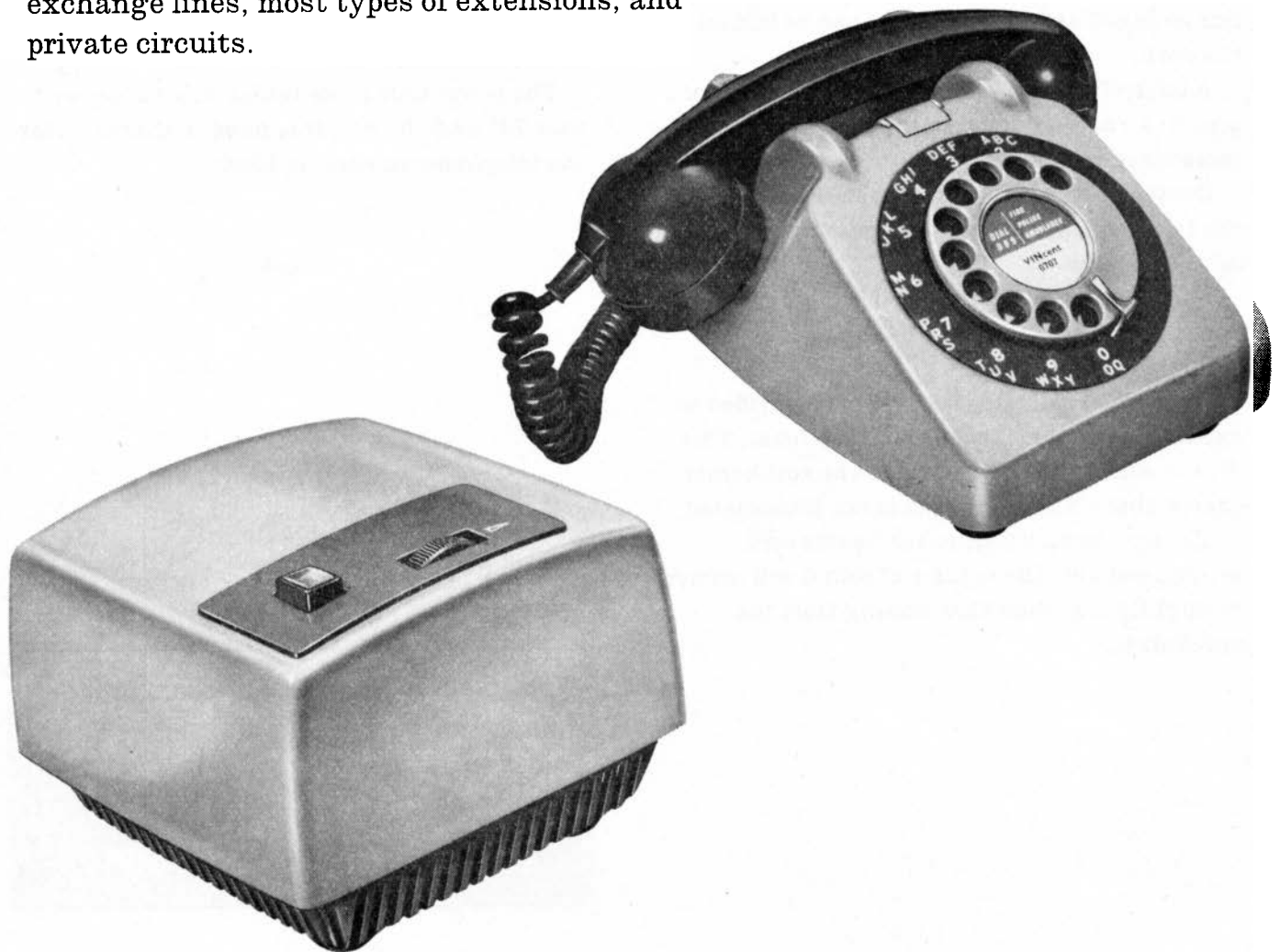
# Speakerset 1

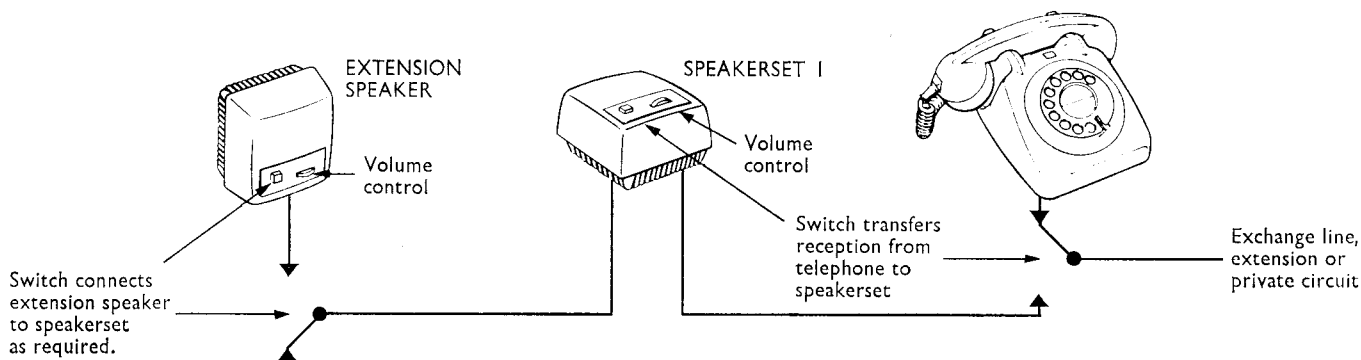

TELEPHONE  
APPARATUS

This attractively designed unit incorporates an amplifier, loudspeaker, volume control and on-off switch, housed in a neat grey plastic case. It amplifies incoming speech and is most useful for broadcasting information or commentaries to a group of people in a large room. It can be associated with telephones connected to exclusive and shared exchange lines, most types of extensions, and private circuits.





## FACILITIES

The speakerset can be switched on at any time during a call; this transfers reception from the telephone receiver to the loudspeaker in the set and disconnects the telephone. The button of the on-off switch shines with an amber light while the speakerset is on.

When switched on, the speakerset holds the line engaged and the telephone can be laid on the desk.

A control is provided to adjust the volume of sound: an arrow indicates the direction for increase of volume.

During a call the line can be re-connected to the telephone handset at any time by switching off the speakerset.

At the end of a call the line is restored, for normal use, by switching off the speakerset and replacing the handset.

An extension loudspeaker can be provided to extend the area covered by the broadcast. This unit is similar in appearance to the speakerset except that its on-off switch is not illuminated.

The extension loudspeaker has its own volume control. The volume of sound will always be slightly less than that coming from the speakerset.

## GENERAL INFORMATION

The speakerset case and the extension loudspeaker case are both 6" by 6" by 4".

The speakerset can stand near the telephone, or can be fixed to a desk or a wall. When an extension loudspeaker is provided, both units must be fixed.

The installation is mains-powered from a 3-pin socket outlet, of at least 2-amp rating, supplied by the customer.

The power unit is contained in a dark-grey case 7½" by 5" by 6½". It is fixed to the wall near the telephone connecting block.
