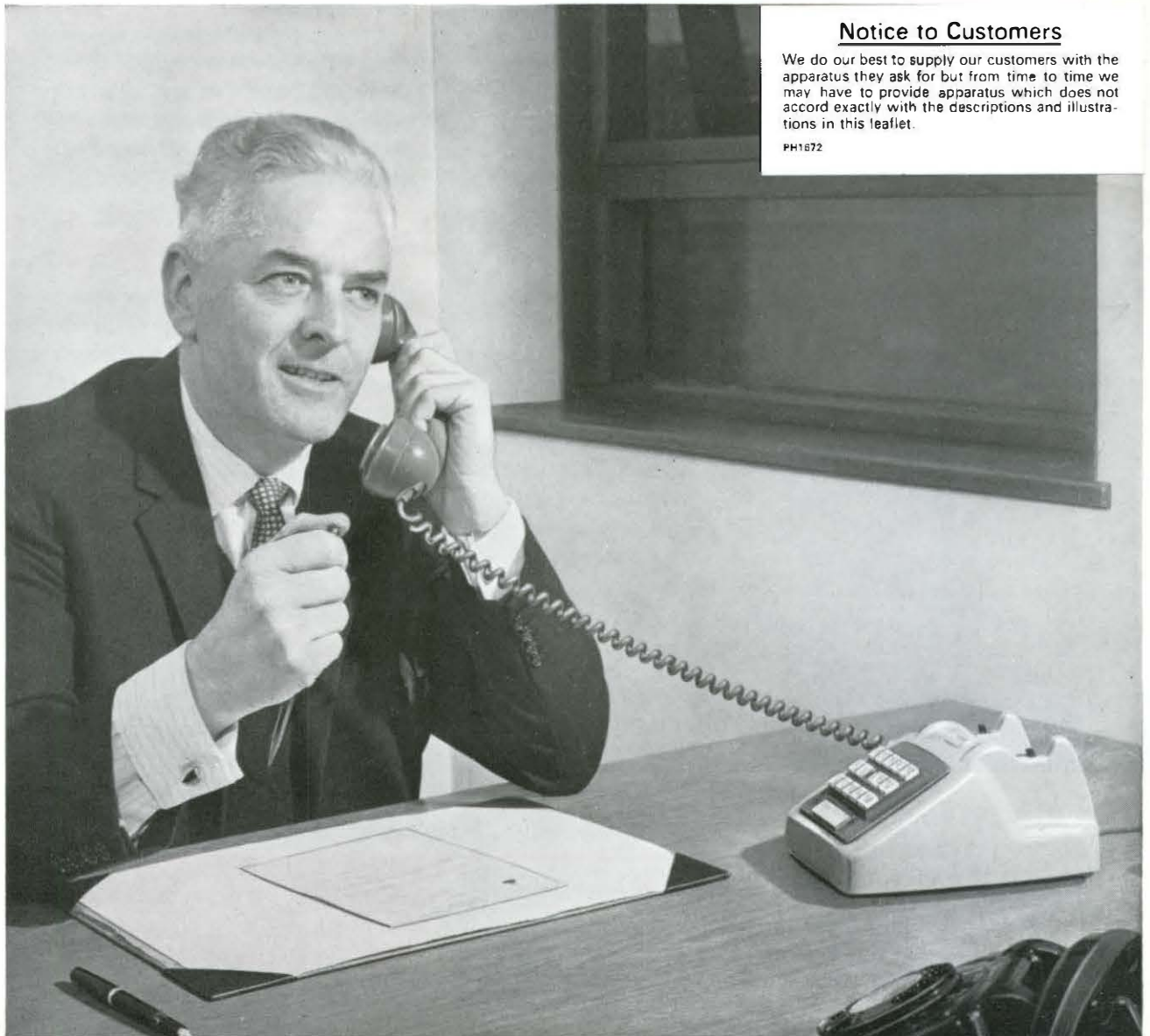

TELECOMMUNICATIONS

This system is an ideal arrangement for groups of people who need to be able to contact one another quickly. It is entirely separate from the public exchange system. The installation is suitable for offices, factories, and large houses, and is simple to use. The modern two-tone grey press-button telephones can be table or wall mounted.

Capacities

Three separate sizes of installation are available, giving 6, 11 or 16 stations which can call one another. These will normally be within the same building, but under certain conditions a telephone can be arranged in another building provided that it is on the same premise and within a short distance.

Facilities

All telephones can be in use at the same time, either on individual calls from one person to another, or on conference calls with several people connected on the same circuit.

To call another station, one simply presses the appropriate button to its full extent, which sounds a buzzer in the called telephone. When released the button returns half-way to a "speak" position. If the called station is engaged on a call the conversation will be heard. The button fully restores when the handset is replaced.

Any number of the telephones can be included in a conference call. Each telephone is called in turn, and asked to call back the station of the person arranging the call and wait until all the required telephones have been contacted.

General Information

Telephones are connected together by grey plastic covered cable $\frac{7}{16}$ " in diameter. The system is mains-powered from a wall-mounted unit which occupies a space 5" by 6" and stands out 4". This unit is connected to a 3-pin socket outlet of at least 2-amp rating supplied by the customer.

The buttons on the telephones have transparent covers which can be unclipped to allow name labels to be inserted to customers requirements.
