Here are some ideas or plans.

Plan 107

is one main telephone and one extension



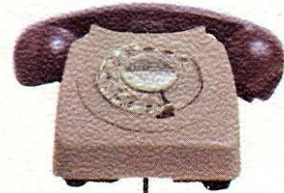
Both are carefully designed to give you the advantages of having telephones in the most needed places.

Take the shopkeeper . . . he needs to communicate with the flat over the shop or with the stockroom and he wants to do it without leaving the counter.

With Plan 107 he has the immediate, almost effortless, answer. A main telephone in the shop, which could be wall mounted to save counter space, and an extension wherever he most wants it. The exchange line can be switched to the Main or Extension. Result, life is easier—more efficient—more business-like.

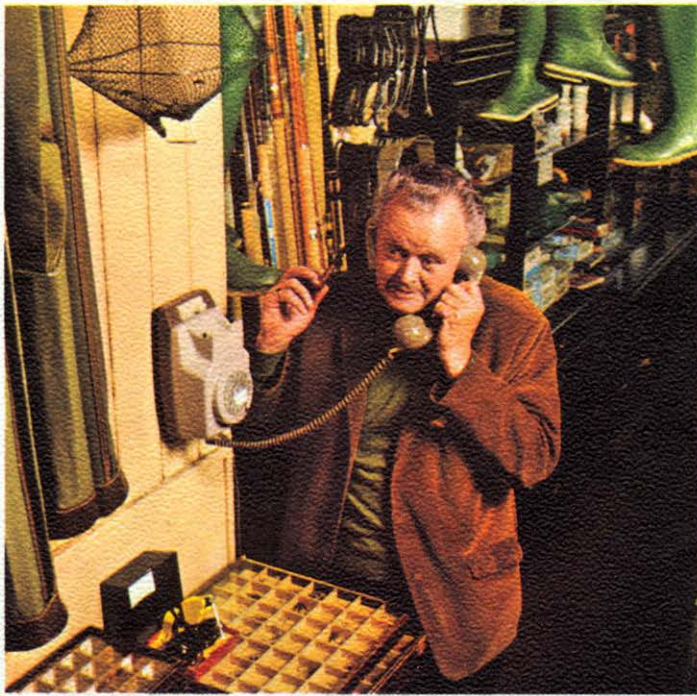
Plan 105

is one main telephone and two extensions

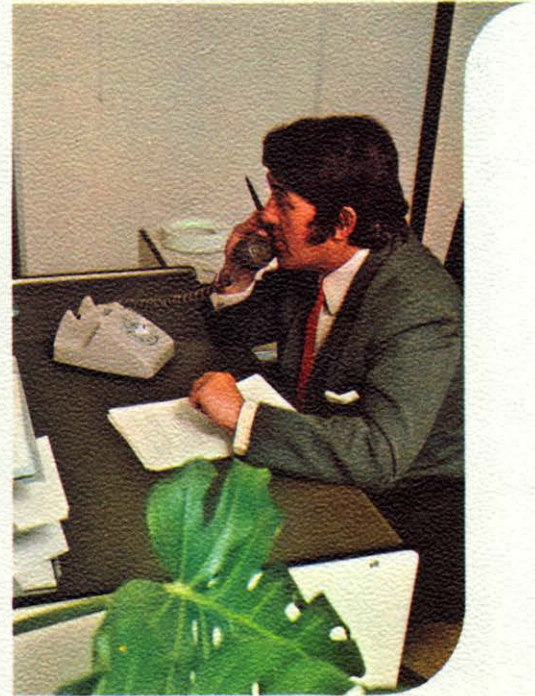


Take a small office . . . with a secretary and two executives. Plan 105 is ideal here. The secretary can filter Exchange calls to each. And in addition there is full inter-communication. Business will stay as it's meant to be, calm, cool and really efficient.

Take Plan 1A for instance

This is a simple way of having up to five extensions on one line. There's no intercommunication between the telephones but calls can be made or received on any of the extensions. This plan would suit a business with several rooms where the occupants are continually on the move and need telephones in different places, or where a group of people in one office share a line and their use of the telephone individually is not heavy.

Then there's Plan 4

You can have lots of telephone points but in effect only rent one telephone. How's it done? Simple, you just plug it in to sockets that are strategically placed around the building. In other words, you would have a 'mobile' tablephone or Trimphone that you can carry with you.

Plan 1

Similar to the Plan 1A but incoming calls are normally received at the Main Telephone and passed to the extension as required.

There's Plan 2

Any one of six telephones can pick up either of two exchange lines (or either of two PBX extensions) at the press of a button.

or Plan 108

Two main telephones, each associated with a separate exchange line, and one internal extension telephone which can be switched to either of the two lines.

When you think about it we have a plan to suit just about every need.

There's colour and style too!

Apart from a variety of systems we can offer a pretty wide selection of colours and styles.

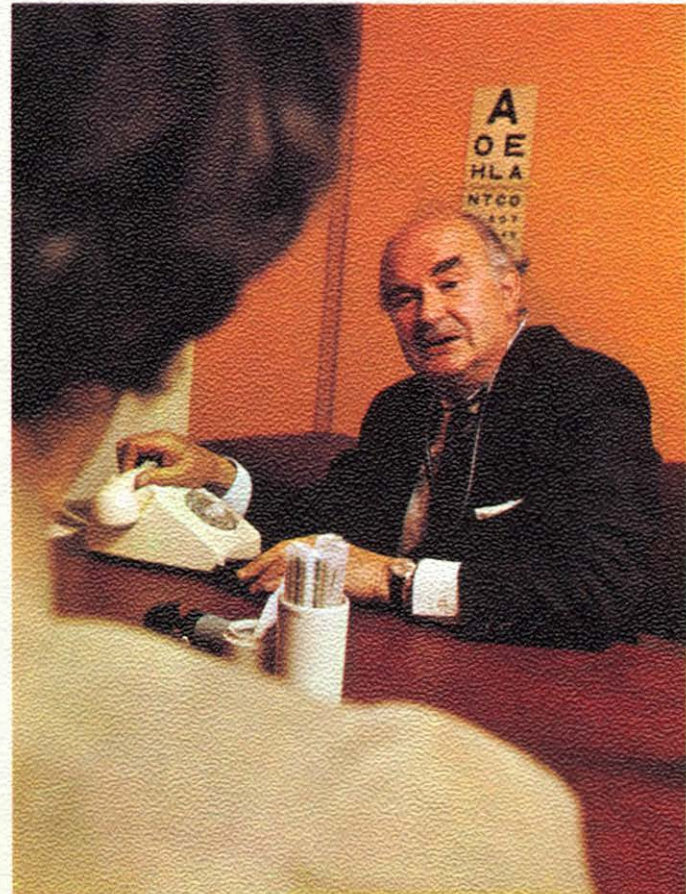

Obviously, we've only given you the bare bones of each system here. When you want to know more, and we are sure you will, contact your Telephone Sales Office.

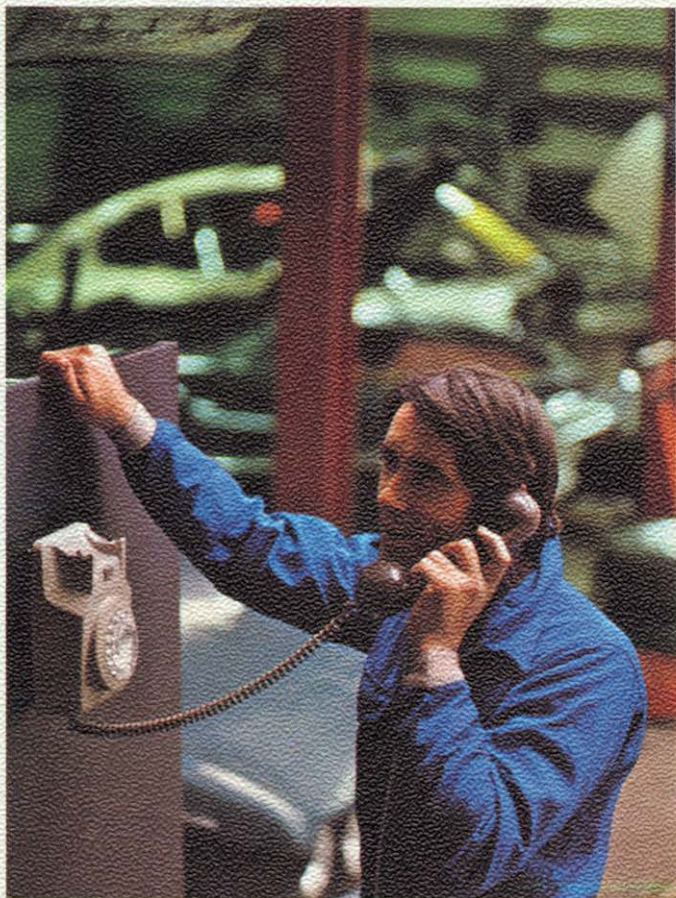
