## *Hand-Microphones*

The hand-microphone is the latest type of telephone—shapely in form and convenient in use. It combines grace of line with efficiency in working and looks equally well in the home or in the office.

In the home it makes a decorative and useful addition to any room. It is ideal as a bedside telephone.

To the office it adds an air of business-like efficiency and neatness. The freedom of movement which it allows is particularly convenient to anyone who wishes to consult papers or to make notes while using it. The compact dimensions make the choice of its position an easy matter.

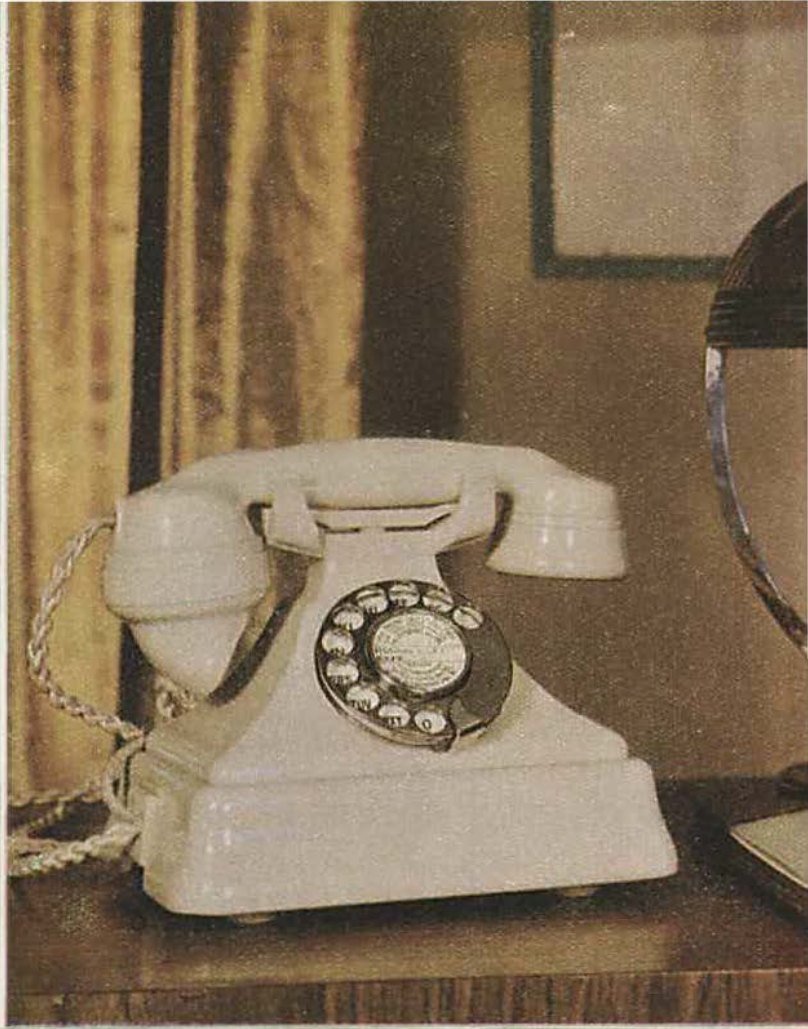
## *The Choice of a Telephone*

In the tastefully furnished house or the skilfully equipped office, the telephones are carefully chosen.

The hand-microphone, in one of the colours in which it is now obtainable, will harmonise with the most fastidious scheme of drawing-room or bedroom decoration. It will take the most distinguished place in the most modern scheme of office equipment.

It can be supplied in black or in three standard colours, green, ivory and red.

A bell set of the same colour as the hand-microphone can be supplied, either as a separate fitting or as a base to the hand-microphone. The "combined set" is particularly useful for fitting on extension lines where a bell-box on the wall would be difficult to fix or would look out of place.

## Charges

The charges for the various models are :—

Black—a *single* payment of 10s.

Green, Ivory or Red—a *single* payment of £1.

Other plain colours, if required, can be supplied to order at a special charge.

No additional charge (other than that made for the black hand-microphone) is made for a black bell set ; for a green, ivory or red bell set an additional charge of a *single* payment of 10s. is made. For other plain colours special charges apply.

The instruments remain the property of the Postmaster-General.

## Dimensions

The ordinary hand-microphone stands about  $5\frac{1}{2}$  inches high on a base approximately  $6\frac{1}{4}$  inches by  $5\frac{1}{2}$  inches. The "combined set" stands about  $7\frac{1}{2}$  inches high, its base being approximately 8 inches by  $6\frac{1}{2}$  inches. The illustrations in this booklet show both types.

## *How to Order a Hand- Microphone*

You may order one or more black hand-microphones (with separate bell sets) by filling up and posting the card marked A which accompanies this booklet.

If you are interested in the coloured instruments or combined telephone and bell sets, fill up and post the card marked B, so that you may discuss your special needs with your local Telephone Sales Representative. He will advise you how your requirements can best be met and will show you samples of the colours in which the instruments are available. It will help if you can give him at least two days' notice.
