

Callmakers





X-Press Callmaker

This will store up to 10 numbers of your choice. The callmaking function is contained within the X-Press Callmaker telephone which has press-buttons in place of a dial. The press-buttons have 2 separate functions: they can be used for making calls as with a normal press-button telephone and in conjunction with the 2 additional buttons, they can also be used as a Callmaker for calling any of the stored numbers.

Lift the handset and press two buttons for quick and easy calling of the stored number of your choice.

A "repeat last number" facility is incorporated in this Callmaker which is a great benefit if the number you have called is engaged or if you get no reply.

The X-Press Callmaker is supplied in an ivory coloured telephone with black press-buttons.



TD Callmaker

The TD Callmaker stores up to 31 numbers in an ivory or simulated wood and black unit which may be desk or wall-mounted close to your phone. This Callmaker incorporates press-buttons which can be used to input telephone numbers into the store or for making calls to numbers not stored. Lift the handset for quick and easy one button calling of the stored number required.

This Callmaker incorporates a "repeat last number" facility.



XL Callmaker

The Callmaker unit is two-tone grey in colour and sits on the table by your phone. It can store up to 46 numbers and incorporates press-buttons which can be used either for making calls in the same way as with a press-button phone or for putting telephone numbers into the Callmaker store.

This Callmaker incorporates a "repeat last number" facility.

The XL has an inbuilt monitor loudspeaker which lets you hear the progress of a call until it is answered — a unique feature within our range of Callmakers.



Card Callmaker

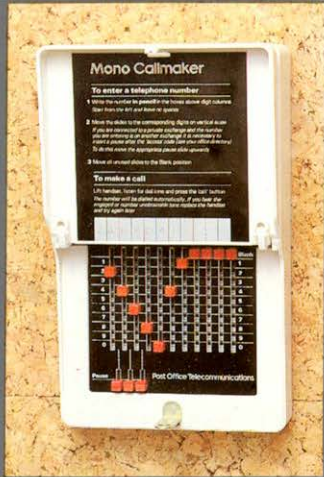
The Card Callmaker has a capacity to meet your needs. Here you punch out in advance a permanent card for each number you wish to store. We supply boxes to hold cards. Why not consider filing a pre-punched card with your customer or client file? To make a call lift the handset of your telephone, select the card you want, and slot it into the Callmaker.

Each Card Callmaker is provided initially with a plastic box containing 50 cards, a set of 9 dividers and a special template and punch. Extra cards can be supplied in multiples of 50 or 1,000 at additional cost.



Tape Callmaker

This Callmaker stores up to 400 names in alphabetical order and records their telephone number on magnetic tape. To make a call simply move the tape to the position containing the name you require. The tape is power driven to speed number selection. Then lift the telephone handset and press the "call" button. A separate dial unit is supplied to record or change stored numbers.



Mono Callmaker

With the Mono Callmaker a telephone can be programmed to call one number of your choice at the press of a button. The programmed number can be changed easily.

The Mono Callmaker is contained in a separate case which can be sited near to the telephone but in a place inaccessible to users if required.

To make a call to the programmed number the user lifts the handset and on hearing dial tone presses a button on the telephone.

The telephone can be used to call numbers other than the programmed number in the normal way.

There are other types of telephone that can be associated with the Mono Callmaker to control the range of numbers that can be called. They are listed on the back page of this leaflet.

Callmakers can replace much of the human element in "getting a number", thereby saving time and reducing the possibility of errors.

Think what it means when you want to call a number you do not know by heart. You – or someone else – must spend time looking up the number and the dialling code. Then it has to be dialled. We all know the feelings of irritation when a wrong digit is selected, or when numbers have to be dialled repeatedly by hand.

Such problems are reduced with a Callmaker. It stores the number and does the dialling for you. The chore of searching in directories, STD code books and telephone lists is eliminated.

A range of 6 different Callmakers is now available.

Types of phone that can be associated with the Mono Callmaker to control the range of numbers which can be called.

1 A telephone without a dial. The user can call the programmed number only.

2 A telephone with a "9" only dial. The user can make 999 emergency calls in addition to being able to call the programmed number.

3 A telephone with a call-barring lock. The dial can be switched in or out of operation whenever you choose so that users can call only the programmed number and 999 emergency calls or have full dial facilities. In this case additional charges apply.

General

All these Callmakers, except the X-Press and Mono, are mains powered, some with a separate power unit, and require to be connected to a 3-pin mains supply socket of at least 3-amp rating provided by the customer. In some situations both a power supply and power unit are required for the X-Press Callmaker. Your local Telephone Sales Office will be pleased to advise you if you require further information about the power requirements of these Callmakers. Each Callmaker is supplied with full operating instructions.
