The versatile Philips KBX6 offers businesses and the professions an efficient range of telephone facilities. These include call hold, enquiry, transfer, with direct intercom at all extensions, programmed ringing, three party conversation, 'hot-line' operation and night service. The KBX6 key telephones, KT2, KT3 and KT5 have two incoming lines with a button and lamp for each line, and 5 intercom buttons.

Distinctive ringing:

Different bell cadences distinguish between exchange (or PABX) calls and intercom calls, with indicator lamps flashing at the ringing cadence.

Direct intercom and three party conversation:

KT2, KT3 and KT5 telephones have pushbutton intercom, enabling the user to communicate directly with any other person on the KBX6 system. Internal conference calls can be set up and, if desired, someone on an exchange line can be included in a three-way conversation.

Hot line:

One of the KT1 or KT4 or any other compatible two-wire telephones can be designated as a 'hot line' and can be at a remote location up to five kilometres from the central control unit. When the 'hot line' handset is lifted, a designated terminal (for example a secretary) will ring for 15 seconds then an exchange line is connected automatically.

Call Barred Hot Line:

A KT1 or KT4 can be restricted to have access only to another designated extension. This is ideal for unattended reception areas or places where you need an emergency telephone.

Compact control unit:

Designed for office environments, the KBX6 control unit is compact and wall-mounted. It is attractively styled, quiet in operation and needs no routine maintenance.

Fast installation:

Three-pair cabling makes for fast low-cost installation and facilities can be programmed in the central control unit at installation.

Telephone choice

Different types of telephone terminal can be connected – including the Philips KT3 feature-phone, which has been designed specifically for the KBX6. In addition, ordinary telephones can be used such as the KT1 and KT4.

More KBX 6 Features & Facilities

Incoming calls

- Handled quickly and efficiently – without a switchboard operator.
- An incoming call causes a corresponding line lamp to flash at all key telephones and initiates ringing at user-selected telephones only.
- Any key telephone can accept the call, simply by picking up the handset and pressing the relevant exchange-line button.
- The same button allows the user to hold a call while an enquiry is made, either internally to another telephone on the KBX6 system, or externally via the other exchange line. A held call can be transferred to another KBX6 extension.
- Incoming calls can be diverted automatically



to another telephone on the system.

- Night service allows outside calls to be routed automatically to specified extensions.

Outgoing calls

Exchange calls can be made from any KBX6 telephone whenever a line is available.

'F' (facility) button for 'Do not disturb', 'Three-party Conversation' and 'Automatic Divert'

If exchange line ringing is not desired, lift the handset and push the 'F' button twice. If you wish a particular exchange line to ring an extension, lift the handset and push the 'F' button once, followed by the desired line key. Repeat this if you wish both exchange lines to ring.

After making an internal enquiry call with an outside call on hold, simply press the 'F' button to set up a three-party conversation.

To divert calls from your terminal, lift the handset, push the 'F' button followed by the top intercom key.

To cancel your divert, lift the handset, push the 'F' button and the next intercom key below.

Interrupt

If you are engaged on an exchange call your secretary may still contact you. By pushing your intercom key both caller and contact will see their line buttons change from steady-on indication to a slow flash. So you need never miss an important message.
