## Colour range

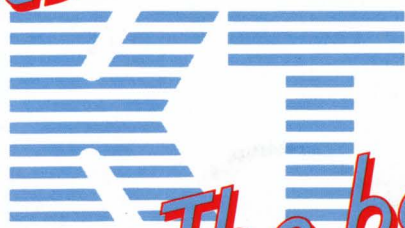
With the KT2, users can choose from a range of attractive colours, to match the decor of each office or residential location. The range includes: light grey, stone, and mid-brown.

#### 'L' button operation

Press once and you're connected to an exchange line. Press again and the call is held. Press a third time and you're reconnected.



#### 'F' (facility) button

Fitted for three very good reasons:

- To recall the operator whilst engaged on an external call.
- To set up a three-way conference.
- To program the system for extension ringing/non-ringing by the exchange.



#### Extension buttons

Just press and you're connected to the extension named on the button — it's as simple as that! These buttons are also used to divert and transfer calls to other extensions.
