

### Four versions

- PABX extension.
- PABX extension with full handsfree operation.
- Planset extension with on-hook dialling.

Both of the PABX versions can be used with Philips or a wide range of other PABXs, but those for use as planset extensions are designed specifically for operation with the Philips KBX3 & 6 electronic keysystems.

### **Autodialling**

KT3 offers single button calling based on dial tone detection — a more certain technique than the usual pause method, which is also available if required. All stored numbers can include dial tone detects, pauses and recall mixed with the digits to ensure single-button access to external numbers via the PABX together with all PABX features.

### Planset version

This version of KT3 exploits the capability of the Philips KBX3 & 6 electronic keysystems and provides direct intercom, three-party conversation and automatic divert.



### Handsfree operation

Here's a very useful feature, especially where you need to take notes or refer to documents or in an office where several people need to take part in your conversation. Also known as a 'loudspeaking' facility, handsfree operation enables all incoming and outgoing calls (via exchange lines or the internal telephone network) to be set up without lifting the handset. And conversations can be held in the same way. But if users prefer to talk more privately they may do so at any time, simply by picking up the handset.

### On-hook dialling

That's right — without lifting the receiver, you can dial any internal or external number you wish!
Simply pick up the handset when you hear the called party answer.

### Repertory calling

Full 49 number capacity. Individually named store locations on touch-sensitive pad provide for any combination of:

- External numbers. Particularly useful for IDD and DDI calls with 28 digit capacity, including dial tone detects and pauses.
- Internal numbers.
- PABX facility codes. Recall storage ensures that all facility codes can be stored for access by a single button press.

### Non-volatile store

In the event of power failure, there's no need to worry about your stored numbers — because the Philips KT3 incorporates a special type of memory (EAROM — for the technically minded), which retains the numbers indefinitely even when the power is off.



### Redial last number

There's a dedicated button which allows the user to redial the last dialled number — and it doesn't matter whether the called party answered the telephone or not. If you need to, you can redial the same number as many times as required.

### Microchip technology

Incorporating advanced microchip circuitry to provide users with a highly reliable, modern telephone instrument.

### Storable recall

Single button call transfer to stored internal extension numbers, also enables storage of PABX facility codes requiring recall for single button access. This ensures maximum use of modern PABX features.



### 16-digit display

Clear, bright fluorescent green display shows: numbers stored, called and keyed; the time on a 12-hour clock; an alarm setting; and the duration of calls or other events in minutes and seconds.

### **Notepad**

Access to the store enables numbers to be displayed or new numbers to be entered even during a call; useful for passing on numbers and keeping new numbers during a call — no more scraps of paper to lose!
