



## **Medway Callmaker**

You're through to any of 200 numbers with a touch of your finger. Like this...

As soon as you have a number you want to use again just pencil the identity on the rollover index. Press the STO key and enter the full number on the key pad, including the exchange access code if you are on a PABX line

It couldn't be easier to make a call Spin through the index. Find the person you want to call, leave the name in the centre of the index window and touch the CALL button You'll see the number being called on the LED display

Your Medway monitor will tell you when the person answers. Only then do you pick up your telephone handset. The moment you pick up the handset the LED display starts timing the call

Using the MON key you can switch to the one way loudspeaker monitor and back to the handset at any time during the call — a useful facility if you have to take notes or let other people hear the call. When your call is finished replace the handset and the Medway Callmaker is waiting for your next order. When it is not making calls the Medway shows you the time and date. The Medway Callmaker is just the size of a desk calculator and is available in mid grey, stone and dark brown

Choose a British Telecom Callmaker – probably the best piece of equipment next to your phone.
