IN TOUCH.

There again, that's one call you wouldn't have to make. Because amongst the Venue's many advanced features is a 24 hour digital clock. An alarm clock, no less, that you can programme to remind you to make that important international call. And should your long distance calls have a habit of getting out of hand, the Venue's built-in call timer lets you keep an eye on the seconds. (The call timer is particularly useful if you have business clients whom you charge for calls made on their behalf)

One of the most popular facilities on today's Inphones is a memory that stores your most frequently dialled numbers. As its name suggests, the Venue will store 24. So your favourite friends, shops and restaurants can all be reached at the press of a button or two.

If any of your friends are engaged—on the phone that is—Venue's last number redial button puts an end to that tiresome business of dialling the same number over and over. There's also a secrecy button that allows you to talk to other people in the room without the person at the end of the line—your bank manager, perhaps? —being able to hear you You may feel that any number one has to obtain from directory enquiries is probably not worth ringing in the first place. But should this course of action be forced upon you, take advantage of the Venue's notepad memory. This clever little facility will store the number you're given, then automatically dial it for you at the touch of a button

All the numbers you dial, whether manually or from the memory, are displayed on the Venue's digital panel to ensure dialling accuracy.

IN TONE.

Venue 24 is, of course, a telephone. But to call it such is to call champagne a drink. The Venue is not for those who are content with the bland, the pedestrian or the common (A higher than average price tag ensures it'll never become the latter) It is designed expressly for those who recognise that a successful blend of form and function produces style, and will look at home in environments that reflect that style.
