CONVERSION

The telephones listed overleaf are fitted with plugs and designed to fit the British Telecom "new style" sockets.

If your existing telephones are not new style plug and socket, you should ask for a conversion to be carried out when you order your new telephone(s).

The charge will be £10 for converting each point on an exchange line plus a visit charge of £15, which may be waived if other chargeable work is carried out at the time of conversion. VAT will be added.

EXTENSION CHARGES

- If you require British Telecom to install new extension phone sockets the charge will be £25 for each extension phone socket plus a visit charge of £15. These charges include the replacement of any British Telecom rented telephones which are on the associated exchange line. VAT will be added.
 - In addition, if the existing main installation is hardwired or connected to old style sockets, then these will need to be converted at a charge of £10 for each point converted.
- From 1st December 1986 you have been able to install your own extension sockets using an approved kit, provided your exchange line point has been converted to a new style master socket. Only British Telecom can convert the master socket for charges see the section marked Conversion.
 - British Telecom supplies a range of approved kits, from complete kits to install 1 and 2 sockets to extra cleats to secure the cable to the wall or skirting board. You can install an extra socket from as little as £9.95. An added bonus is that if anything goes wrong with a BT kit over the years, a BT engineer can call to fix it with the cost depending on how long it takes. (Kits are available from your local British Telecom Sales Office or from BT Shops and other high street stockists).

- The British Telecom offers a maintenance service for purchased telephones on a quarterly charge basis.
- The first specific form of the garden of the appropriate "access line" charges will apply.
