## **PLEASE NOTE**

This is a simple guide; it is not intended to be a comprehensive list.

Exchange line charges are not included; these are given in General Information leaflet DLX 1.

The full connexion charges are shown, but in certain instances reductions are made.

The charges and rentals shown in this leaflet are correct as at 1 October 1970, and the decimal currency charges and rentals which apply from 15 February 1971 are shown in italics. The charges and rentals may be revised subsequently by the Post Office.

For each extension within the building (internal extension) from these switchboards, there is a connexion charge of £3 (£3) and a quarterly rental of £1 (£1).

For an extension between buildings (external extension) there is a scale of connexion charges starting at £5 (£5) and a scale of additional rental starting at £1 5s (£1·25), both based on distance.

We do our best to supply our customers with the apparatus they ask for, but from time to time we may have to provide apparatus which does not accord exactly with the descriptions and illustrations in the leaflets mentioned.
