Large PABX Keyphones DC "C" and MF

These instruments are for use with Direct Current "C" Code or Multi-Frequency Signalling PABXs.

Keying is an easier and faster action than dialling.

They speed the connexion of extension to extension calls, using the faster switching capabilities of these PABXs.



The Keyphones are two-tone grey and available as table or wall mounted models. The handset has an extensible coiled cord which extends from 200mm to 1670mm.

Each instrument has a 3m grey line cord. Longer cords of 5m and 8m are available.

On DC "C" Code systems the key marked

is to give recall facilities.

The key marked

has no present use.

On some MF systems both the key marked \square and \times may be used in the operation of special large PABX facilities. The exact use of the keys varies with the PABX type.

Mounted Keypad

Please note

Operation

The handset is lifted and when dialling tone is heard the number required is obtained by keying the digits in turn.

Incoming calls operate a bell inside the keyphone, and calls are answered by lifting the handset.

Other applications

Loudspeaking Telephones No. 4, with keypads instead of rotary dials are available on direct extensions. In other situations where keypads are required on a Loudspeaking Telephone No. 4 the Telephone Sales Office should be consulted. Facilities, other than the keypad, offered by these instruments are described in leaflet DLE 512.

Separate Key Units, which can be table or wall mounted, are available for use with DC "C" Code signalling PABXs. The unit is in a grey plastic case and weighs 420 gms.

Key units can also be associated with a pendant telephone or where a separate keypad is needed instead of the normal keyphone. In the latter case a handset or headset and a bell are also necessary.

A keypad mounted in a drawer or under a desk top and associated with a pendant telephone can be provided for use with DC "C" Code PABXs on direct extensions, or plan arrangements where not more than one press button is needed.

Plan extension arrangements

Various combinations of two or more instruments connected to the same PABX extension, or a number of extensions connected to the same instrument, giving different facilities can be provided.

Self-Contained Keyphones suitable for use on other types of PABXs are also available.
