Answering/Recording Machine 101A

This machine is ideal for business and domestic use.

It answers your telephone in your absence or when you are busy and invites callers to leave a message; gathers information from clients, representatives or responses to advertising and allows friends and relatives to leave a message when you are away from home.

Opening announcements can be changed as often as you wish and a library of cartridges can be built up to cover varying circumstances.

Description

The Answering/Recording Machine 101A is connected to your telephone by a plug and socket arrangement. The machine is supplied with three interchangeable announcement cartridges and one message recording cassette. A separate hand microphone, which can be put away when not in use, is provided for recording announcements and dictation.

Facilities

The machine is designed for the maximum flexibility of use and provides the following facilities:-

Announcement cartridges provide for on opening announcement lasting 35 seconds and a closing announcement of 8 seconds which alerts a caller, should he remain silent for a while, that the machine is disconnecting from the line.

A library of announcements can be built up to cover varying circumstances although an existing announcement is automatically erased as a new one is recorded.

Incoming messages are recorded onto a message cassette which allows for a total message recording time of 30 minutes. The cassette can be removed from the machine and played back elsewhere on your own cassette player if desired.

Both your announcements and incoming messages can be played back through the loudspeaker incorporated in the machine. A volume control is provided to adjust the volume to suit individual circumstances.

Additional announcement cartridges and message cassettes can be purchased

from your local Telephone Sales Office. Fast forward and rewind allow for rapid location of messages. A tape position indicator is also provided for easy location of particular messages.

There is no need to erase messages as this is done automatically the next time the tape is used. Should you wish to erase a message for security reasons an erase facility is featured.

Having answered your telephone you may hand over a caller to your machine so that a message can be recorded. You can also override the machine when in operation and take over a call personally.

The machine can also be used as a simple dictation machine.

How it operates

The machine is simple to operate using two banks of piano type keys similar to

those used on common cassette players. Easy to follow instructions are supplied with every machine.

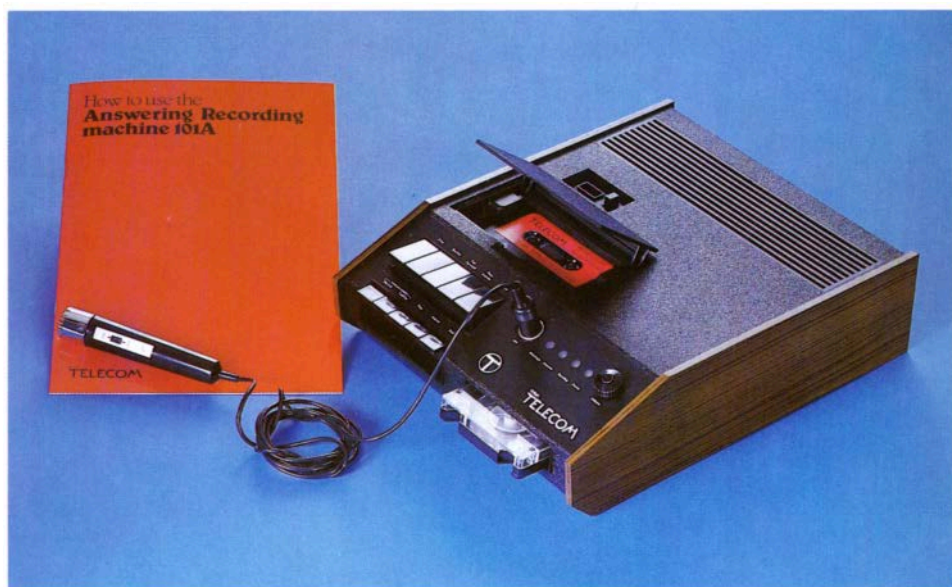
General

There are certain special conditions which apply to the provision of answering/recording machines with which the customer must comply. These will be explained on application to your local Telephone Sales Office.

The machine can be used on most types of exclusive exchange lines and switchboard extensions. It is not possible to use the machine on shared service lines.

The machine measures 257mm x 330mm x 89mm and weighs 5.67 kgs.

The customer must provide a 3-pin mains electricity supply socket of at least 2-amp positioned within 3 metres of the machine.
