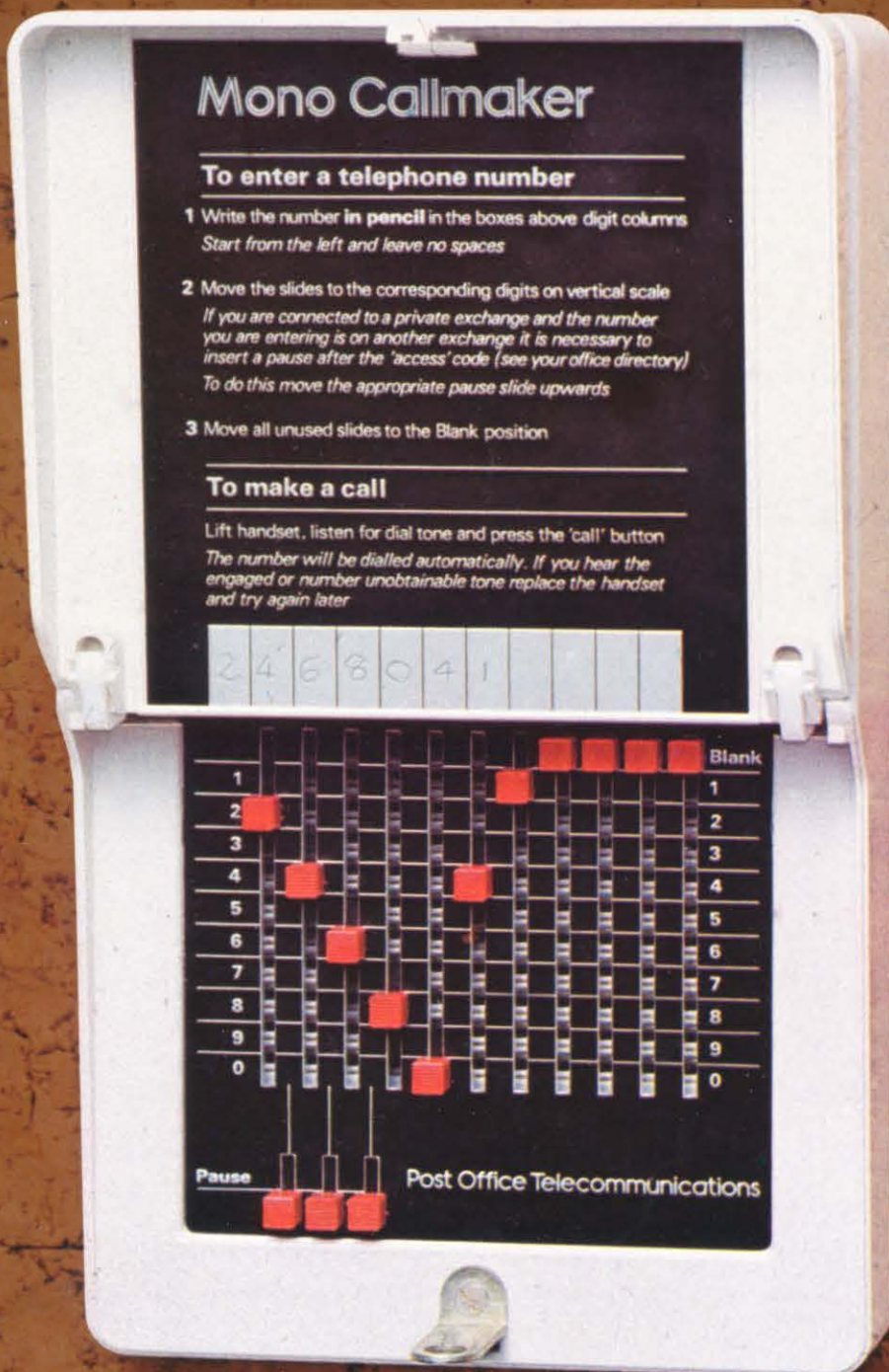


Mono Callmaker



With a Mono Callmaker a telephone can be programmed to call one number of your choice at the press of a button.

The Mono Callmaker is ideal at locations such as airports, stations or docks where the public may require direct access to car hire or hotel facilities.

Description

The Mono Callmaker is contained in an off-white case which measures approximately 250mm X 150mm X 50mm.

A hinged lid at the lower half of the Callmaker allows access to programme a single telephone number.

Programming is achieved by a matrix of vertical slide switches. There is a cable connexion between the Callmaker and the telephone which permits the two items to be fitted in separate locations (subject to certain technical limitations).

It has been designed to be wall-mounted and requires no power unit.

How it operates

The instructions are printed on the underside of the lid as shown in the photograph overleaf.

To Enter A Telephone Number

1. Write the number in pencil in the boxes above the digit columns. Start from the left and leave no spaces.
2. Move the slides to the corresponding digits on the vertical scale.
3. Move all unused slides to the blank position.

To Make A Call

Lift handset, listen for dial tone and press the call button on the telephone.

Facilities

The Mono Callmaker is capable of storing one telephone number up to 11 digits. (When the Callmaker is used on a Private Automatic Branch Exchange extension it is possible to programme the exchange line access digit).

There are four different types of telephone which can work in combination with the Callmaker thus giving a range of different facilities.

A Telephone Without A Dial

The user can call the pre-set number only.

A Telephone With "9" Only Dial

The user can make 999 emergency calls in addition to being able to call the pre-set number.

A Telephone With Call Barring Lock

The dial can be switched out of operation whenever you choose so that users can call only the pre-set number or the 999 emergency service. The phone can be switched back to full dial facilities whenever required.

A Telephone With Full Dialling Facilities

This telephone can be used to make calls either to the pre-set number by pressing the call button on the telephone or other calls can be dialled using the phone in the normal way.

General

The Mono Callmaker can be provided on most telephone installations, but there are a few types of extension arrangements to which it cannot be fitted. Your local Telephone Sales Office will be pleased to advise you.

The Mono Callmaker can be remotely sited from the telephone it is associated with to aid security.
