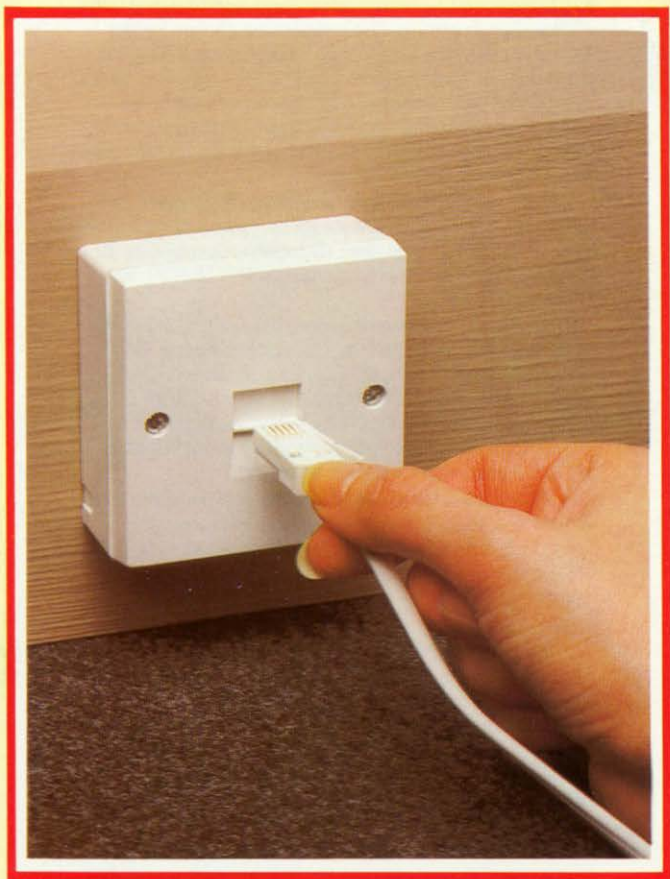

# **NEW** Phone sockets from British Telecom

## **bring mobility to the telephone**

Instead of fixing telephones permanently into position we now install phone sockets where you want them in your home. From now on moving your phones around the home is simple—just unplug from one socket, and plug in to another.

If you already have a telephone in your home and you want to extend it, say, to your bedroom, we'll be pleased to fit a phone socket there and to supply you with a plug-in phone. The installation charge for the phone socket will be £25 (£28.75 including VAT) and the quarterly rental will be 15p (17.25p including VAT). The cost of the telephone will vary according to the model you choose. When we fit your extension phone socket we will convert your existing phone to new plug and socket at no extra charge.

If you are having a new telephone line connected to your home and you ask for an extension phone socket to be fitted at the same time, the connection charge for the extension socket will be reduced to £18 (£20.70 including VAT).

While our engineer is in your home he will be glad to fit extra phone sockets at the much reduced installation charge of £10 each (£11.50 including VAT). So for example you could have three extension sockets fitted for £45 (£51.75 including VAT). And don't forget, we would convert your existing phone to new plug and socket at the same time—for no charge.

There is a wide range of telephones to choose from, so now is a good time to plug in to our new phone sockets. For further details contact your local BT Sales Office; you will find the number in the front of your telephone directory.

### **Please note.**

We do our best to supply our customers with the apparatus they ask for but we may have to provide apparatus which does not accord exactly with the descriptions, illustrations and shades of colours shown in this leaflet. Telephones are available from other suppliers which may be connected to the British Telecom system. Should you wish to buy one of these we do urge you to make sure that any telephone you do buy is approved for connexion to the public telephone network.
