

SL-1 FEATUREPHONE



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The SL-1 Featurephone is an electronic telephone supplied exclusively by British Telecom to SL-1 PABX owners to provide customers designed call feature operation, tailored to individual user requirements.

Description

The Featurephone has twelve press-buttons for making internal and external calls and is also equipped with ten non-locking buttons for line pick-up and 'feature' operation, eight of which have light emitting diodes (LEDs) associated with them as visual indicators. An additional three button strip allows control of the speaker volume and provides Hold facility. On-hook dialling is a standard facility on the SL-1 Featurephone.

Adisplay version of the basic telephone includes a sixteen digit display strip located above the twelve press-buttons.

The 10 button module has eight LED indicators and the 20 button module has sixteen LED indicators. Blanking plates are provided on both sides of Featurephones and Button modules to allow expansion using more than one module. Button modules can be provided to allow up to a maximum of sixty feature buttons and are always fitted to the right of the basic telephone.

A Handsfree Module allowing loudspeaker operation is available and is always fitted to the left side of the basic telephone.

The Featurephone is available in Chameleon Grey, with a black press-button backplate and red LEDs.

Operation

Features are activated by the operation of an assigned button. The system confirms the feature operation via either the LED associated with the button or by audible response, or both. A speaker is located under the cover

below the handset for voice calling, tone ringing and buzzing.

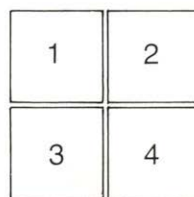
Special Notes

Power Add-on Modules require an additional 24v 50Hz power supply which can be provided either from a small local power unit using an adjacent 13-amp mains power source, or directly from an auxiliary Power-Card on the system via an additional pair of wires. Each Power-Card can supply up to eight Featurephones.

PBX Equipment PBX Extensions served by SL-1 Featurephones will only operate with the discrete Line-Card associated in the system designed specifically for the purpose. Each Line-Card can serve up to four Featurephones.

Provisions of Power and Line-Cards are the responsibility of the PABX supplier.

Advice on Feature button layouts can be obtained from the PABX supplier.
