The Venue 24E is in a class of its own. Sleek and distinctive, in sophisticated black, two-tone cool white and grey, or subtle beige, it has a host of useful high-tech features.

At home or at the office, Venue 24E is the phone for people who want more than just a phone.



A tone to match the time and place

The Tone Caller has a volume control which you can adjust at any time. Turn it down when you don't want the phone to wake the children. Turn it up when you're going to be some distance from the phone and you don't want to miss a call.

Keeps trying for you

The Venue 24E automatically remembers the last number you dialled. So if it was engaged, for instance, just press the clearly marked LAST NUMBER button and the Venue 24E will automatically redial for you.

An electronic notepad at your fingertips

You're having a conversation or calling directory enquiries and someone gives you a phone number to write down.

No pen? No paper? No problem!

Without interrupting your conversation, you just tap the number into the keyboard and it appears on the liquid crystal display.

When you replace the handset, the number is stored in the notepad for recall and automatic dialling whenever you wish.



Keep it to yourself

No need to put your hand over the mouthpiece when you don't want the person on the other end to hear what you're saying (the Venue 24E is sensitive enough to pick up whispers anyway). Just hold down the SECRECY button for total privacy.

Remembers numbers and dials them for you

The Venue 24E will memorise and store up to twenty-four 16 digit phone numbers, and dial any of them for you at the touch of two buttons.

It's invaluable when you've better things to think about, and also avoids the chance of misdialling—especially those long international numbers.



You can see what you're doing

The liquid crystal display shows the number as you dial it, so you can be sure it's right before the call is connected.

It also displays any numbers recalled from the memory.

It tells the time and date

The liquid crystal display also functions as a calendar clock. Useful when you want to remind yourself of the day and date as well as the exact time.



It can time calls for you

If you need to record the length of a call—to keep control of your phone costs, or to charge the costs on—the Venue 24E has a timer which will display the call duration (and store it in the memory until the next timed call).

It's an alarm clock

You can set the Venue 24E to give you an alarm signal, just like an alarm clock. Useful for that early morning wake up call, or as a reminder to make a call at a particular time.

The phone for the future

If you think that the Venue 24E is sophisticated now, just wait. It won't be long before you'll be shopping by phone, banking by phone or calling on all manner of exciting phone services that are now being developed.

The Venue 24E is a 'dual signalling' phone which means that you'll be ready to switch in to all these exciting services as soon as they become available.

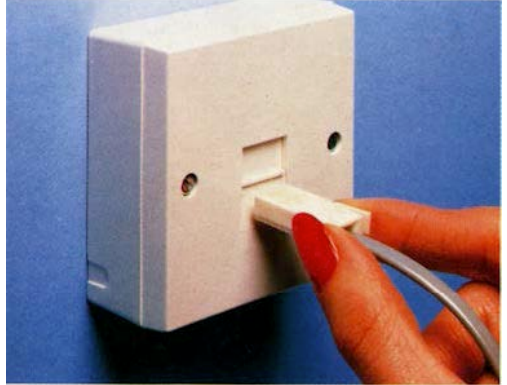
Freedom & flexibility with today's sockets
