Introduction

With the increase in the type and range of telephones available it is becoming exceedingly difficult, for those of us who speak to our customers, to recall all the colours, types and facilities.

To help overcome this problem we have prepared this aide memoire for quick reference to customer benefits, charges and relevant leaflets. New and updated sheets will be provided as required.

It may help if the following points are kept in mind when using this aide:-

- 1** The customer cannot ask about our full range of telephones if he does not know it exists.
- 2** We must not assume in advance that the customer will prefer a standard instrument.
- 3** We should not encourage a "single telephone in the hall" approach by the customer.
- 4** It is easier to talk about style and colour once the location of the telephone(s) has been decided.

5 Remember, you have the information and the customer is relying on your words to paint the picture.

6 Do not leave the customer in the air—when in doubt follow up with a leaflet.

The range of telephones is divided into 3:-

Standard Telephones: Common instruments supplied within the charges for the installation.

Premium Telephones: Instruments that offer some variety of style and facilities. A limited choice at extra charges.

Special Telephones: A wider choice made to meet the requirements of the discerning customer. A range of extra charges apply and a variation of terms and conditions.
