


## Electrical Symbols

The symbols were traced in Corel Draw from a scanned image of drawings made with my old Uno stencil. Each symbol has been exported as a Windows Metafile, WMF.


These files can be imported into many applications, including Microsoft Word, Excel and Visio - or even back into Corel Draw. I found that when they are imported into Word I have to ungroup them and re-group them before I can manipulate them. A slight annoyance. They can then be rotated, flipped, copied and joined with lines to form a circuit diagram.
